Executive Summary

Elswick Community Pool and Leisure Centre has been a cornerstone of the local community since reopening in 2019. Since we reopened we have operated under the name Elswick Community Pool and Gym.

Located in one of Newcastle's most deprived areas, our mission is to provide accessible and inclusive leisure services that improve health, well-being, and social inclusion. Through our extensive programs, partnerships, and community outreach, we have positively impacted thousands of lives. This report highlights our achievements, partnerships, and future goals as we continue to serve our community. Our facility operates over 90 hours per week, welcoming an average of 2,750 visitors weekly. We provide essential services, including swimming lessons, fitness programs, and employment training, while maintaining a strong focus on sustainability and financial resilience.

Our Story & Mission

The Pool at Elswick was originally closed by Newcastle City Council in 2015 due to financial constraints. However, a dedicated group of local residents fought to save the facility, recognising its crucial role in community health and social engagement. After significant campaigning and business planning, the centre reopened under local charitable control in 2019.

Our mission is to provide affordable and inclusive fitness and swimming opportunities to all members of the community, regardless of background or ability. We focus on improving physical and mental wellbeing, increasing employability through training courses, and strengthening community ties.



Key Achievements

- Serving Over 32,000 People Annually: Our facility welcomes thousands of visitors every year, helping improve physical and mental well-being.
- School Engagement: We currently provide swimming lessons to 20 primary schools, ensuring children develop life-saving water skills.
- Learn to Swim Programme: On average, over 2,000 children learn to swim with us each year through school swimming lessons and our Learn to Swim programme.



- Lifeguard & Swimming Teacher Training: Over 60 individuals have been trained as lifeguards, with over 80% now employed. We have also trained 14 swim instructors, all of whom are now working in the field.
- **Specialist Sessions**: We provide tailored activities for different groups, including over-50s and over-60s classes, gender-specific swim sessions, and disability-friendly swims.
- **Community Support Initiatives**: We partner with local organisations to offer free facility access to vulnerable groups through Public Health England (PHE).
- Community Outreach & Events: We actively participate in initiatives such as litter picks and local events to promote a clean and safe environment.
- Recognition & Awards: Awarded: the North East Holiday Activity Project of the Year, Best Voluntary Sector Recognition Award, SME Northern Enterprise Award. Nominated: Swim England Swim School of the Year and Phil, one of our swim instructors, Swim Teacher of the Year.

We also engage in community events, health initiatives, and partnerships with local schools and businesses to ensure a broad and lasting impact.





Financial Transparency & Funding

Our funding model is a **mix of earned income**, **grants**, **and donations**. In 2023-24, we generated £856,323 in revenue, primarily from:

- Group lessons (£229,770)
- Wet activities (£195,039)
- Memberships (£147,388)
- School swimming and lane hire (£99,076)
- Club hire (£72,022)
- Various other sources


We have also secured grant funding from Power to Change, Places for People, Carbon Homes, Sport England, and by working with Newcastle City Council we secured funding from The Public Sector Decarbonisation Scheme, the New Green Deal Fund and Swimming Pool Support Fund, which helps us sustain our community programs.

Environmental & Sustainability Impact

Elswick Community Pool and Gym is currently undergoing a £2.825 million refurbishment as part of the Decarbonisation Scheme, including:

- Installation of air source heat pumps to replace gas heating
- Solar PV panels for renewable energy generation
- Triple-glazed windows and roof insulation to reduce heat loss
- LED lighting upgrades to lower electricity consumption
- Pool covers to improve energy efficiency

These improvements are expected to reduce energy costs by over £1 million in the next 30 years, ensuring long-term financial sustainability while significantly reducing our carbon footprint.



Future Plans & Goals

Looking ahead, we plan to:

- Expand our swimming lesson programme to reach more schools and community groups.
- Increase accessibility by offering more free and subsidised sessions for disadvantaged individuals.
- **Develop our gym facilities** to attract more members and diversify revenue streams.
- Enhance our community engagement strategy, including membership expansion and governance improvements.
- Improve facility usage by introducing new classes, well-being workshops, and personal training options.
- **Strengthen partnerships** to bring even more health and wellness initiatives to the centre.
- Maintain financial sustainability through careful budgeting, fundraising, and operational improvements.
